

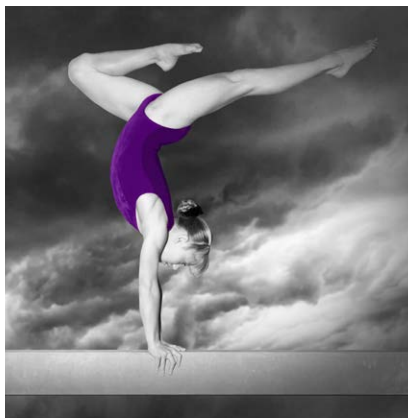

ENTRY FORMAT

Entrants are required to pose and answer a question, based on current evidence, relating to dairy and sport nutrition through one of the following means:

- Literature Review
- Primary Research Study
- Case Study

The piece of work should be 1500 words $\pm 10\%$ excluding references, tables & figures, and cover page. The written work must be in the style and format of a research article and include the following information on a cover page:

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ABSTRACT

(150 words max)

THE PURPOSE OF THE AWARD IS TO GIVE NEW SPORT NUTRITIONISTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO SHOWCASE THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE ROLE OF DAIRY FOODS IN SPORT NUTRITION AND ELITE PERFORMANCE.

AWARD CRITERIA

- 1.** The applicant must be a BSc, MSc or PhD student, or SENr graduate.
- 2.** The applicant must submit a 1500 word $\pm 10\%$ literature review, primary research piece or case study which answers a research question specific to the role of dairy in sports nutrition.
- 3.** The written work must follow the given format (ENTRY FORMAT) in the style and format of a research article. Entries which exceed word limit will be penalised.
- 4.** Applications not adhering to the award criteria will not be marked.
- 5.** The decision is final in all cases and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 6.** The award will not be made in the absence of submissions of sufficient merit.

Judgement will also be made on the overall impact, innovative or practical observations, and clear, consistent writing. Entries that appear to sell a particular product will not be considered.
